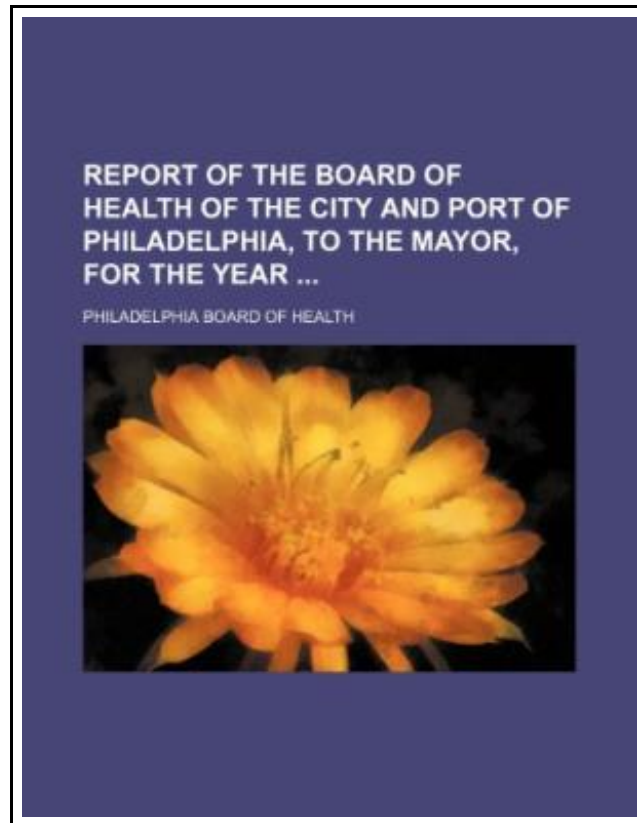

It should be explained that the unusually high death-rate for the year 1872, was caused by the epidemic of small-pox, which was so fatal in the first quarter of that year, and by the severity of the weather of the summer months. 6 The deaths in 1875, arranged according to months and quarters of the year, are as follows: The order of mortality by quarters was, third, first, second, and fourth. This corresponds with the usual order. In 1872, owing to epidemic influence, the greatest mortality occurred in the first quarter; then, in the third, second, and fourth quarters, in the order named. This is an exception to the usual order. Of the deaths in 1875, 25.72 per cent, took place in the first quarter; 25.52 per cent., in the second quarter; 27.21 per cent., in the third quarter; and 21.55 per cent., in the fourth quarter of the year. The greatest mortality occurred in August, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-six (1,926) deaths, or 10.82 per cent, of the total mortality, being registered in that month. Of this number, a large proportion was of children under five years of age. March, June, and July, present successively the next greatest mortality, the total number of deaths for these months being five thousand three hundred and fifty-six (5,356), or 30.08 per cent, of the total mortality. December, May, February, and April follow next in order, the difference in the number of deaths in...
